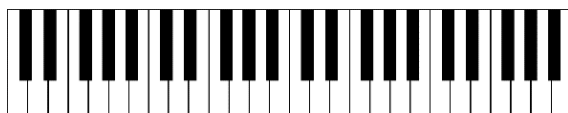




Music Theory Workshops
